6:45 Doolittle Bay Trail and Shoreline Improvements – Project Update with participant Q&A

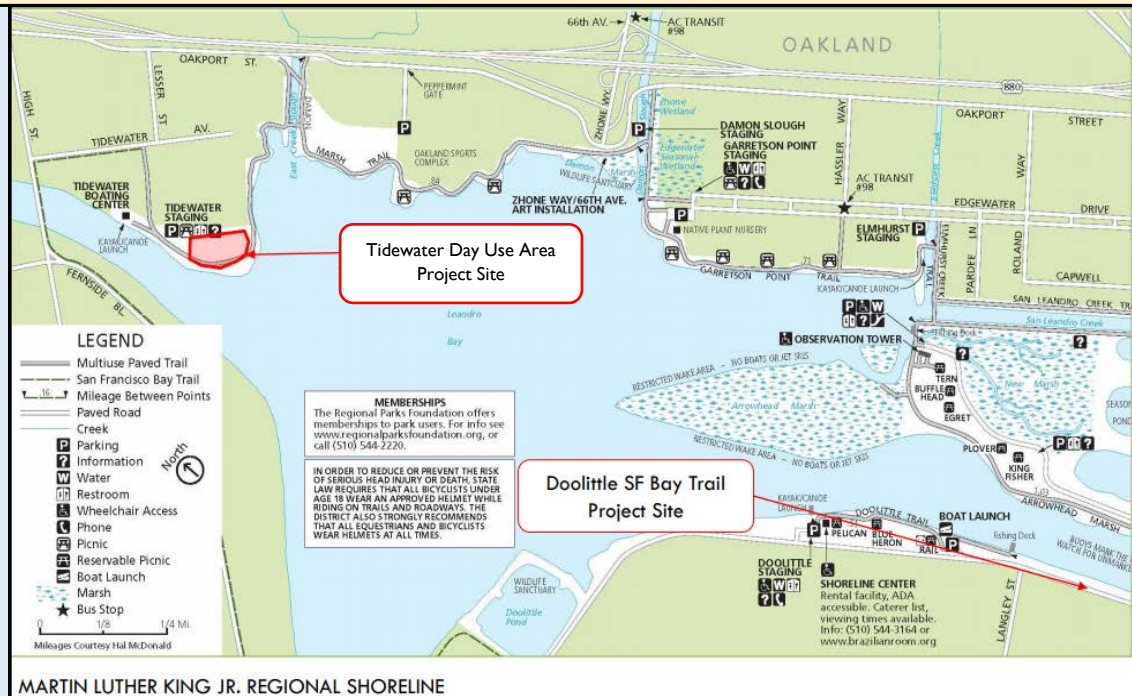
